*Genesis 17:1–8, 15–21*

<sup>1</sup>When Abram was ninety-nine years old the LORD appeared to Abram and said to him, “I am God Almighty; walk before me, and be blameless, <sup>2</sup>that I may make my covenant between me and you, and may multiply you greatly.” <sup>3</sup>Then Abram fell on his face. 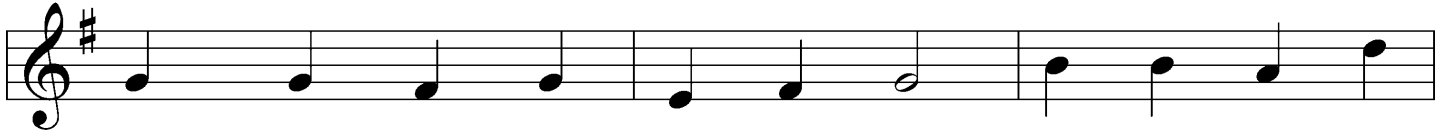
<sup>34</sup>And Mary said to the angel, “How will this be, since I am a virgin?”
