- But if we confess our sins, God, who is faithful and just, will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.


# **CONFESSION OF SINS**

My hour has not yet come." <sup>5</sup>His mother said to the servants, "Do whatever he tells you."


<sup>6</sup>Now there were six stone water jars there for the Jewish rites of purification, each holding twenty or thirty gallons. <sup>7</sup>Jesus said to the servants, "Fill the jars with water."
