

NICENE CREED

I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth and of all things visible and invisible. LORD'S PRAYER



my heart is like wax; it is melted within my breast; ¹⁵my strength is dried up like a potsherd, and my tongue sticks to my jaws; You lay me in the dust of death. ¹⁶For dogs encompass me; a company of evildoers encircles me;

they have pierced my hands and feet ¹⁷I can count all my bones—

they stare and gloat over me; ¹⁸they divide my garments among them, and for my clothing they cast lots. ¹⁹But you, O LORD, do not be far off! O you my help, come quickly to my aid! ²⁰Deliver my soul from the sword, my precious life from the power of the dog! ²¹Save me from the mouth of the lion! You have rescued me from the horns of the wild oxen!²²I will tell of your name to my brothers;

in the midst of the congregation I will praise you: ²³You who fear the LORD, praise him! All you offspring of Jacob, glorify him, and stand in awe of him, all you offspring of Israel! ²⁴For he has not despised or abhorred the affliction of the afflicted, and he has not hidden his face from him, but has heard, when he cried to him.²⁵From you comes my praise in the great congregation; my vows I will perform before those who fear him.²⁶The afflicted shall eat and be satisfied; those who seek him shall praise the LORD! May your hearts live forever!27All the ends of the earth shall remember and turn to the LORD, and all the families of the nations shall worship before you.²⁸For kingship belongs to the LORD,
