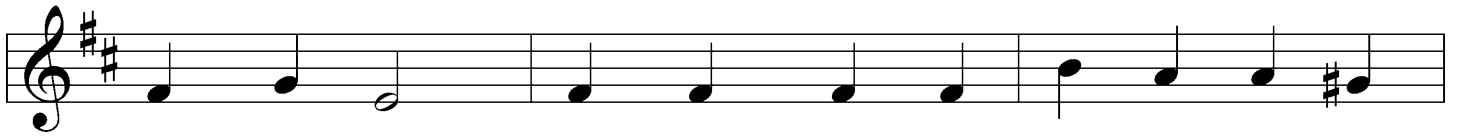

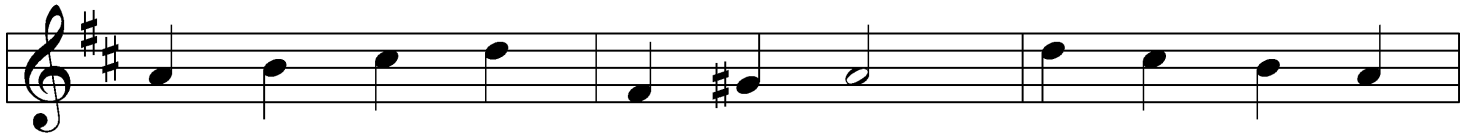

**C** Amen.

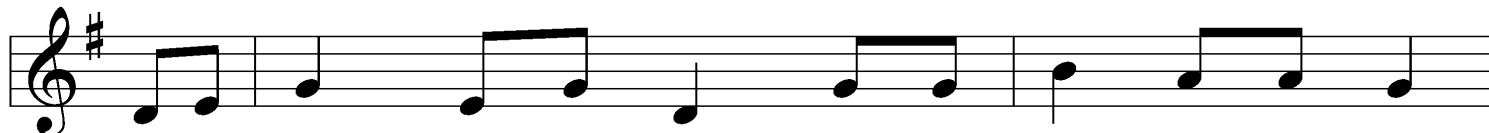

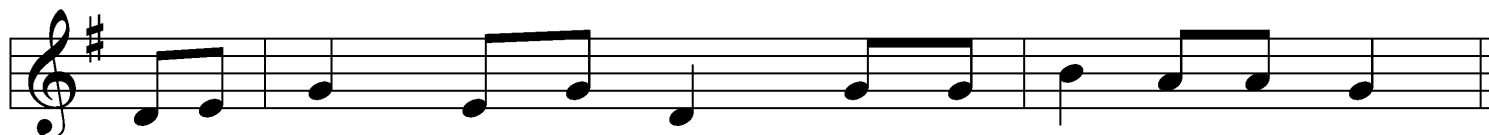

**NICENE CREED**

**C** I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth and of all things visible and invisible. 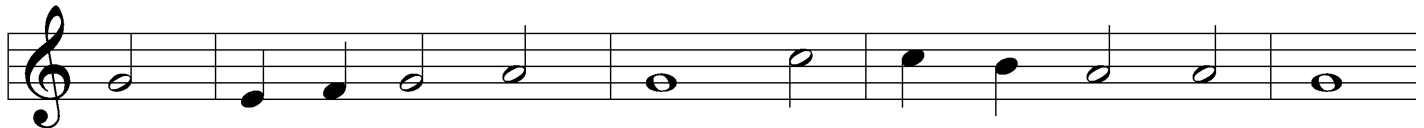
### PRAYER
