## ABSOLUTION

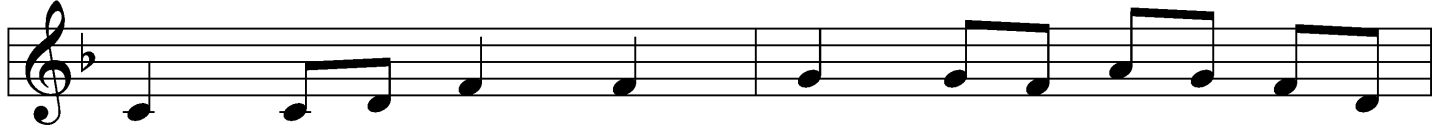
