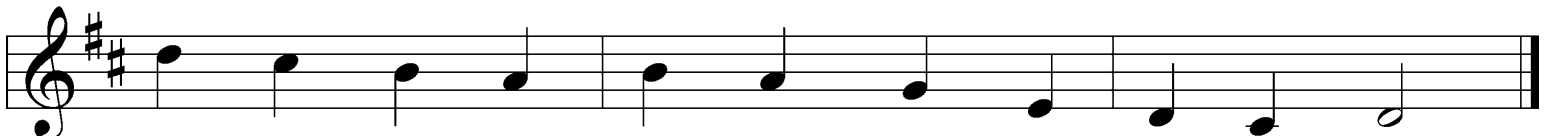

ABSOLUTION

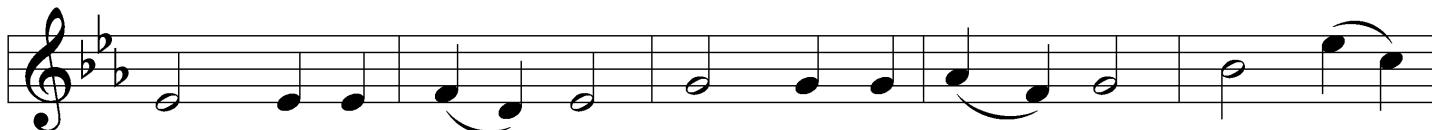
