**C** Amen.

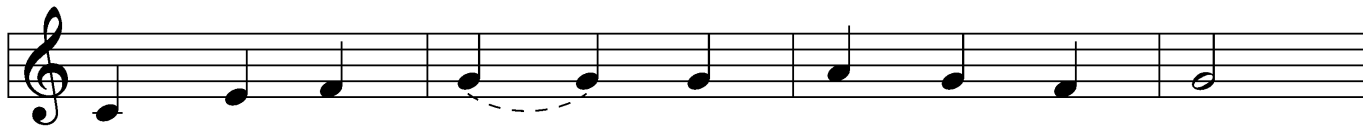
