ABSOLUTION

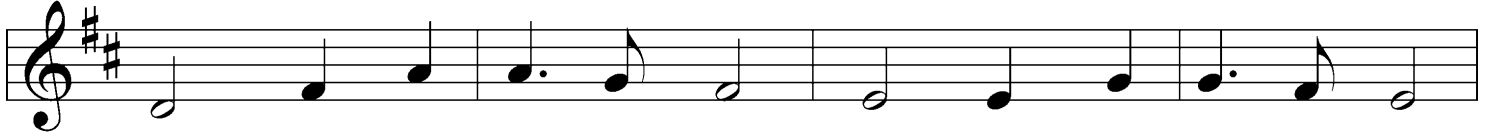
