CONFESSION OF SINS

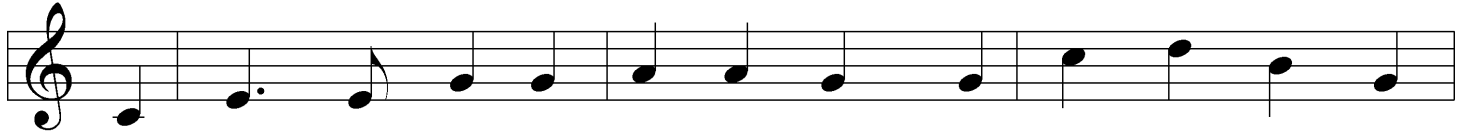
P Let us then confess our sins to God our Father.

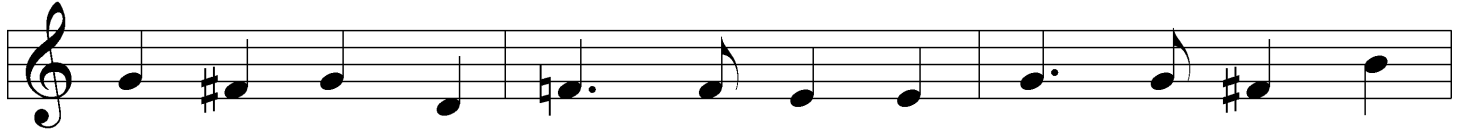
ABSOLUTION

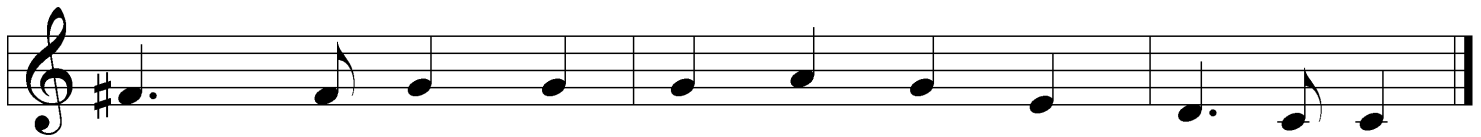
